THE CLEAN HOUSE

'if you do not clean, how do you know if you've made any progress in life?'

Sarah Ruhl is an award-winning American playwright born in 1974. Described as 'a sublime playwright' and 'deliriously imaginative and fearless in her choice of subject matter'. She is perhaps best known for In the Next Room (or The Vibrator Play) which concerns the 19th century practice of doctors using the vibrator to bring women to orgasm as a treatment for "hysteria." This will give you an idea of her sensibilities!

The Clean House premiered in 2004 at Yale Repertory Theatre, and was produced Off-Broadway in 2006. It was a finalist in the Pulitzer Prize in Drama, 2005 and won the Susan Smith Blackburn Prize 2003-2004 (for the best English-language play written by a woman). The 2008 touring UK production featured Patricia Hodge and Eleanor Bron.

Paula Vogel says that "reading a Sarah Ruhl play is a little akin to falling in love". We agree! Variety called The Clean House "A wondrously mad and moving work". From the first time I picked up the script I was blown away by how Sarah Ruhl deals with difficult and dark issues in a beautiful and often hilarious way, and by the strong women in her story.

Dreamlike and poetic, yet acerbic and very funny, The Clean House blends comedy, surgery, apple picking and infidelity in a cocktail of magic realism. It is a beautiful play about love, death, laughter and the messiness of life. We have moved the setting from a 'metaphysical Connecticut' to somewhere a little closer to home

Some of the more surreal elements of the play have been creatively challenging, but its been great fun to weave in special effects, video and choreography to create a multi-textured piece of theatre.

Rather than trying to perfectly mimic reality, we have exposed the make-believe at play. I think that this is one of the great joys of theatre - we know its pretend, but for a couple of hours we can pretend that we don't. At the same time, the characters, feelings and reactions are painfully real - perhaps more so because of the illusion around them.

It has been an absolute delight to work with a brilliant cast and crew to bring this magical play to life. We hope you'll love it as much as we do.

Kerri began acting at the age of 13 as a member of Croydon Youth Theatre where she spent over 10 years and acted in over 30 productions including taking the title roles in 'Anna Christie', 'The Prime of Miss Jean Brodie' and 'Educating Rita' She worked at sea for a decade but has now returned to her acting roots. Her most recent production was a community play at Printer's Playhouse in Eastbourne where she also took an acting course. 'The Clean House' is Kerri's first play at NVT but she hopes it will not be the last!

Jozede Scrivener - Victoria

Jozede trained at Rose Bruford College. She has workshopped with Augusto Boal and Simon McBurney, and cites Brecht as a major influence in her writing for the theatre. She has an MA from Sussex University in Dramatic Writing, and her work has been staged in the Brighton Festival. She has recently performed at the Marlborough Theatre's 'Hidden Cabarets', writing and singing darkly funny songs with her band, Saucebox. This is her first role for the NVT





Shaila Alvarez - Matilde

This is Shaila's third appearance at NVT. Her first role was as Helen of Troy in 'Women of Troy' March 2016 and Constance at the 400th anniversary of Shakespeare's death. She has also performed at the Fringe Festival as Clara Schumann, The Television Terrorist, Kate in 'The Taming of the Shrew', among many others. Recently she has appeared in a short film by Ridder Levitt playing the role of inspiration. Shaila has studied and workshopped different acting techniques such as Meisner technique with Scott Williams, Alexander technique with Korina Biggs and acting technique, voice work and improvisation at PPH. Shaila wants to dedicate this performance to her father.

Jeremy Crow - Charles / Father

This is Jeremy's fifth appearance at the NVT. He first played David in 'Benefactors' in the 2014/15 season, and last season appeared as Marley's ghost and in a number of other guises in 'A Christmas Carol', as Major Glendinning in 'How Many Miles to Babylon', and as a member of the ensemble for 'Love and Information'. He also performed with the Southwick Players as Theseus in last summer's production of 'A Midsummer Night's Dream'.





Diane Robinson - Ana / Mother

This is Diane's 1st NVT appearance, however she has been Acting and Directing since studying Drama at University of London Goldsmiths College. Diane's Educational career has enabled her to direct over 25 shows with a range of Young people.

Favourite Acting roles include Maggie- 'Outside Edge,' Mrs Bennett- 'Pride and Prejudice,' Lady Pembroke- 'Madness of King George,' Agnes- 'Dancing at Lughnasa,' Jan - 'Bedroom Farce,' Madge- 'The Dresser,' Betsy Trotwood- 'David Copperfield.' and Marie- 'Calendar Girls.'
